



Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Dear Valued Customer,

Thank you for contacting Electro Enterprises regarding the subject of “conflict minerals” and Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act. Electro Enterprises is aware of the conflict minerals reporting obligations set forth by Section 1501 of the US Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform Act.

As a global distributor of electronic components, Electro Enterprises is not able to provide accurate information regarding the use of conflict minerals in the products that we distribute. Furthermore, manufacturers have confirmed that distributors are not authorized to provide this information to their customers, and that the manufacturers themselves are the only source for accurate information regarding any substances used to manufacture their products.

Electro Enterprises is fully aware of the importance of this issue and will work with all of our customers to get them the information they respectfully require. Information from manufacturers concerning the use of conflict minerals is currently being compiled by the Electronics Components Industry Association and the Electronics Industry Citizenship Coalition. Electro Enterprises is also working with our customers and getting them in contact with our applicable manufacturers on a case-by-case basis.
